PRE-CONFERENCE WORKSHOP I

AWHONN Intermediate Instructor Course 8:00am to 5:00pm Michelle Flanagan, BSN, RNC

The Intermediate Instructor Course is a one-day, classroom, train-the-trainer program that focuses on the principles of adult learning, teaching strategies specific to the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course, and information about the administrative and operational aspects of the course. Included within the program are opportunities to present sections of the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course as a micro-teach exercise and scenarios of difficult educational situations that may occur when teaching the course.

Objectives of the Intermediate Instructor Course:

- ◆ Identify administrative responsibilities, policies and procedures of the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course
- ◆ Demonstrate navigation of the AWHONN and the online Data Management websites for administrative functions
- ◆ Apply principles of adult learning and teaching to the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course
- ◆ Demonstrate entry level proficiency in teaching selected segments of Intermediate Course (lecture & skill stations)
- ◆ Manage classroom issues & formulate problem-solving techniques

To be eligible to participate in the Intermediate Instructor Course, the candidate must:

- ◆ Document active licensure as a registered nurse or physician
- ◆ Maintain current AWHONN membership
- ◆ Document a minimum of two years of recent experience in intrapartum fetal monitoring
- ◆ Document current clinical involvement in intrapartum fetal heart monitoring (FHM) as a staff nurse, physician, manager, clinical nurse specialist, advanced practice registered nurse, certified midwife, or educator with inclusion of responsibilities for direct assessment of intrapartum EFM clinical skills of others
- ◆ Maintain professional development in intrapartum, antepartum, high-risk care and FHM through attendance at relevant continuing educational activities
- ◆ Submit evidence of successful completion of the current edition Intermediate Fetal Monitoring course within three years of the Intermediate Instructor Course. The application must include documentation of knowledge validation, course date and the number of the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course.
- ◆ Complete the Conflict of Interest, Licensing Agreement and Financial Declaration Statements

Participants are awarded eight (8) hours of continuing nursing education CNE credit for completion of the Intermediate Instructor Course.

Continuing Education Hours are provided through the AWHONN learning system and not through AHEC.

Concurrent Sessions Group A

A-1 Alternate Methods of Pain Relief for You and Your Clients | Megan Stark CD(DONA), LCCE

This program will provide the learner with a toolkit of alternative options for pain relief and comfort for their labor and delivery clients.
